

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully before registering for the Event. By registering for the Event, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, the Promoter's Policies and the Purchase Policy and Terms of Use of the Ticketing Agent.

1. Interpretation

In these Terms and Conditions, the following words have the following meanings:

"Group" means a collection of Participants registered as one group

"Event" means the Junior Theatre Festival New Zealand

"Event Registration Pack" means the registration pack and information distributed by the Promoter which details specific information for that year's Event

"Participant/s", "You" means the individual participants including, but not limited to, performers, group leaders and chaperones

"Promoter's Policies" means any policies adopted by the Promoter including, but not limited to, the Health and Safety Policy and Code of Conduct.

"Promoter", "Us" means the Amici Trust

2. Registration Fees

2.1. Group registration fees and Participant registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

2.2. The Promoter may choose to offer discounted early bird pricing in accordance with the Event Registration Pack.

2.3. The Promoter takes all reasonable care to ensure that registration fees are correct at the time of purchase, however, should an error occur, the Promoter reserves all rights to correct any errors made. The Promoter will contact the purchaser as soon as practicable should any correction be required.

2.4. Should you wish to make any changes to your booking following purchase, the Promoter and/or Ticketing Agent may charge additional administration fees. The Promoter reserves its rights not to allow changes made to Group bookings within seven days of the Event.

2.5. All prices and transactions are in New Zealand dollars ((NZ\$)).

2.6. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, amend or vary the Event at any time prior to the Event taking place.

3. Group Sizes

Groups must have a minimum of 25 total Participants, 15 of which must be students. Groups acknowledge that if they have less than the minimum number of Participants, the Group will be charged the minimum registration fees.

4. Cancellation Policy

4.1. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel or postpone the Event due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control including, but not limited to, an act of God, war, resolution or any other unlawful act against public order or authority, an industrial dispute including strike or any other labour disturbances, a governmental restraint, or where a state of emergency has been declared (an event of Force Majeure).

- 4.2. If the Promoter is required to cancel or postpone an Event due to an event of Force Majeure or for any other reason, the Promoter will offer you the option of:
- 4.2.1. A full refund of your registration fees; or
 - 4.2.2. Exchange your ticket for a re-scheduled Event.
- 4.3. If the Promoter authorises refunds, they will be issued only to the original purchaser or to the original credit card used for the purchase in accordance with the Ticket Agency's Purchase Policy.
- 4.4. Nothing in these terms (including specifically, this clause) shall limit the Promoter's liability for any breach of the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or the Fair Trading Act 1986 (including any liability for consequential loss suffered by a consumer that cannot be excluded) or will or purport to limit any consumer's rights that cannot be limited by New Zealand Law.

5. Variations to Event

The Promoter reserves the rights to add, withdraw, reschedule or substitute artists and/or vary the advertised programs, prices, venues, seating arrangements and audience capacity at any time.

6. Conditions of Entry

- 6.1. Please allow sufficient time to complete appropriate sign in measures for the Event. You will be required to acknowledge additional specific information provided in relation to the Event and sign release forms.
- 6.2. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission with reasonable cause including, but not limited to, lost or damaged tickets, tickets not purchased through the Ticketing Agency, or valid identification is not provided.
- 6.3. Late arrivals may not be admitted to the Event until a suitable break in the Event.
- 6.4. You will be refused entry to the Event if the Promoter, or anyone acting on behalf of the Promoter, considers that you are intoxicated, under the influence of illicit drugs, inappropriately attired or your behaviour adversely affects the enjoyment of the Event by others.
- 6.5. Wristbands will be provided to each Participant within a Group. Participants agree not to transfer wristbands between registered and non-registered Participants or within a Group.
- 6.6. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any Participant, or a Group, should any wristband found to be damaged, tampered with or defaced in anyway.

7. Child Protection

- 7.1. Group leaders and/or chaperones always agree to maintain responsibility for their registered students before, during and after the Event.
- 7.2. In accordance with Ministry of Education guidelines, the Promoter requires the minimum ratio of students to chaperones at 7:1.

8. Recording, Transmission & Exhibition

- 8.1. You agree not to record or transmit, or aid in recording or transmitting, any description, account, picture, or reproduction of the event without the Promoter's express consent.

8.2. Cameras, video and audio recording devices, mobile phones and pagers may not be permitted in certain activities within the Event.

8.3. The Promoter reserves the right to remove any Participant from the Event without compensation for breach of any rules in this clause.

9. Privacy Policy

9.1. All Participants grant the Promoter and their affiliates including Music Theatre International Australasia, iTheatrics, Disney Theatrics and Hal Leonard Australia the right and permission to use and publish the photographs/film/videotapes/electronic representations and/or sound recordings made of the Participants and hereby release the Promoter and the affiliates from any and all liability from such use and publication.

9.2. All Participants authorise the reproduction, sale, copyright, exhibit, broad cast, electronic storage and/or distribution of any photographs/film/videotapes/electronic representations and/or sound recordings made of the Participants without limitation at the sole discretion of the Promoter and its affiliates and specifically waive any rights to any compensation or any of the foregoing for an unlimited duration.

10. Licencing

10.1. Groups may only perform a show from within the MTI Broadway JR. or KIDS Collection.

10.2. Your show must have been licensed by your Group either the year prior to the Event or the year of the Event.

11. Limitation of Liability

11.1. If the Event is cancelled in accordance with clause 4.1, all liability is limited to the amount of the registration fees paid (including fees and charges). Unless required by law, the Promoter will not be liable for any other losses incurred by you because of cancellation, rescheduling or relocating an Event including any travel and accommodation expenses.

11.2. By attending the Event you agree to the terms of these conditions on behalf of yourself and any accompanying minor. You assume all risks incidental to the Event, whether before, during or after the Event, except that nothing in this section limits your rights and remedies under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or the Fair Trading Act 1986.

12. General

12.1. The Promoter reserves the right to vary these Terms and Conditions at any time. The current Terms and Conditions are available from the Promoter's website for public access.

12.2. Groups acknowledge that they are responsible for making their own travel, accommodation and food arrangements before, during and after the Event.
